



OBPS 'Bring Your Own Device' Specifications 2021

The BYOD program applies to Stage 2 and 3 students (years 3-6) only. The program is optional. If you choose to participate in the program, the device your child brings to school should meet the following requirements:

Form Factor	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • iPad 2 or any generation beyond • iPad air • Preferably not iPad mini but these are sufficient • 16GB or above will be adequate
Physical Dimensions	Minimum Screen Size as per iPad

Wireless Compatibility (WiFi)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • iPad has built in Wi-Fi
