



## OBPS 'Bring Your Own Device' Specifications 2019

The BYOD program applies to Stage 2 and 3 students (years 3-6) only. The program is optional. If you choose to participate in the program, the device your child brings to school should meet the following requirements:

<b>Form Factor</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• iPad 2 or any generation beyond</li> <li>• iPad air</li> <li>• Preferably not iPad mini but these are sufficient</li> <li>• 16GB or above will be adequate</li> </ul>
<b>Physical Dimensions</b>	Minimum Screen Size as per iPad
<b>Operating System</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• IOS 11 or whatever is most current</li> </ul>
<b>Wireless Compatibility (WiFi)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• iPad has built in Wi-Fi</li> </ul>
